Every 10 minutes, **a woman is murdered** by someone in their own family.

For 20 years, the gender gap in labor force participation has **remained stagnant**.

In just one year, the proportion of **women killed in wars** doubled.

Women and girls contribute the least to **climate change**—yet suffer its worst consequences.

Emerging **technologies** promise equality but are weaponized against women and girls.

Accelerate the achievement of **women's full and equal decision-making power** in private and public domains, and at all levels of government, including by applying temporary **special measures**.

Drive accountability for the **women, peace and security agenda** and gender-responsive humanitarian action by adopting fully financed national action plans and **funding local women's organizations** leading responses in crises and conflicts.

Prioritize women and girls' rights, including from rural and **indigenous communities**, in the transition to environmental sustainability, by centering them in **climate action and the conservation of biodiversity**, ensuring they can develop new skills to gain green jobs and guaranteeing their **access to productive assets and land rights**.
