

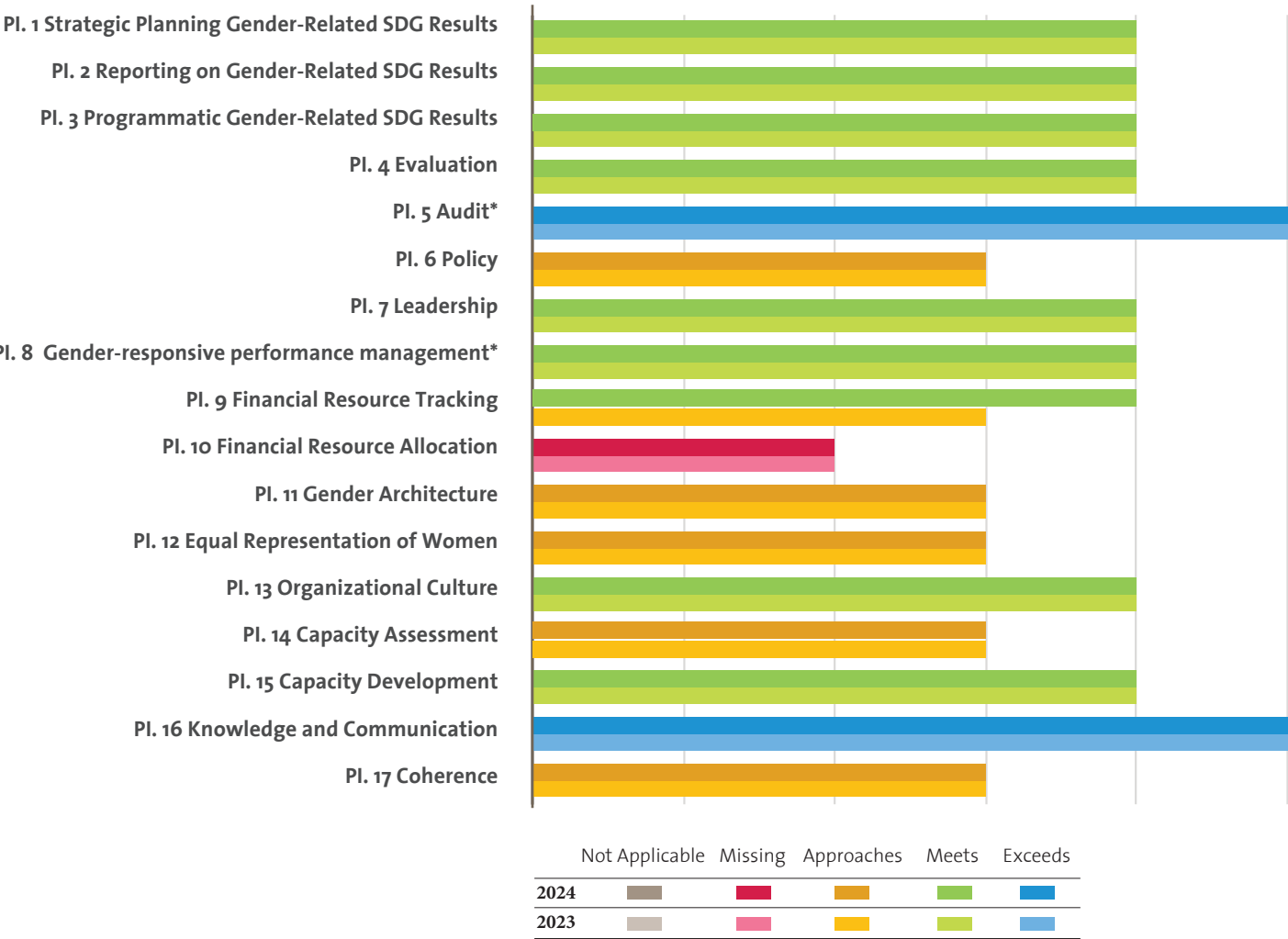

In 2024, UN DESA met or exceeded the requirements for 11 out of 17 applicable performance indicators.

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2024

Most significant gains

In 2024, UN DESA exceeded requirements on two indicators: Audit and Knowledge & Communication. UN DESA consistently performed at the top level on these indicators for the past five years.

UN DESA maintained steady performance by "meeting" the requirements for another nine indicators.

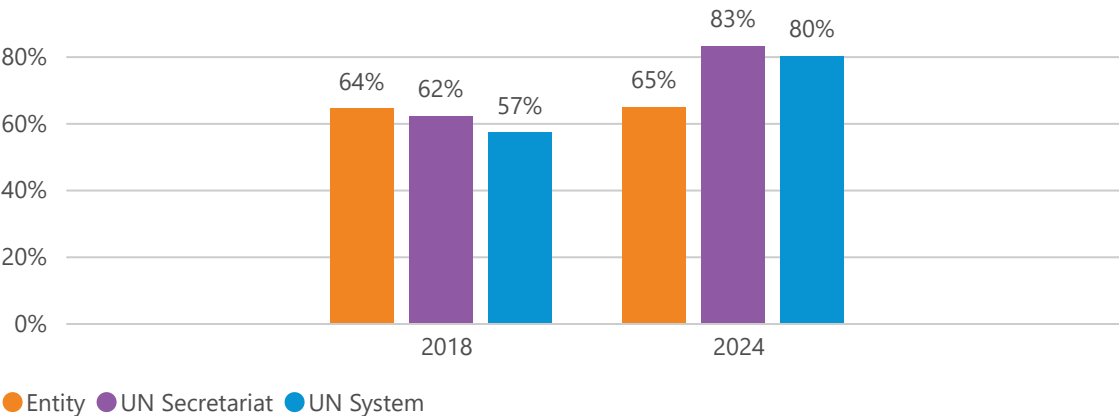
Areas for improvement

UN Women encourages UN DESA to focus on the Financial Resource Allocation indicator, which remain "missing" requirements, and on the four indicators rated as "approaching" requirements, particularly the Gender Policy indicator.

* Performance Indicators 5 on Audit and 8 on Gender-responsive performance management are jointly reported for all UN Secretariat entities by OIOS and DMSPC, respectively.

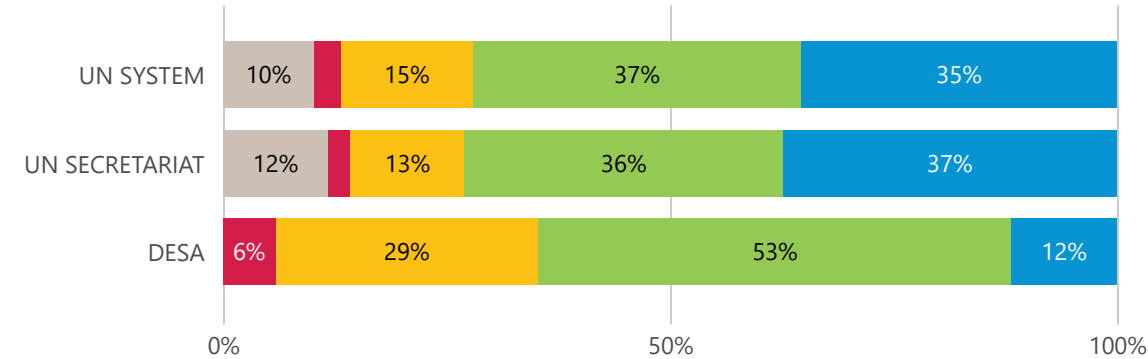
COMPARISON OF OVERALL PERFORMANCE WITHIN THE UN SYSTEM, 2018-2024

PERCENTAGE OF RATINGS MEETING/EXCEEDING REQUIREMENTS (NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS OMITTED)



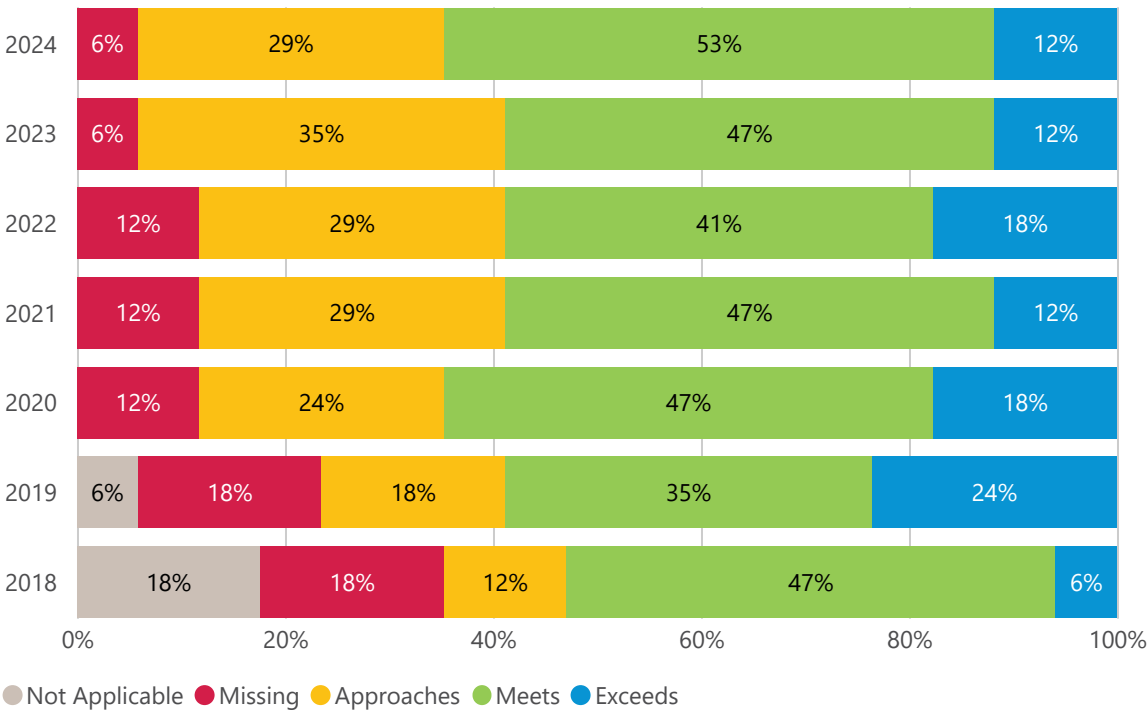
In 2018, UN DESA outperformed the UN Secretariat entities and the overall UN System on average. In 2024, the UN Secretariat entities and the overall UN System, on average, outperformed UN DESA.

COMPARISON OF RATINGS WITHIN THE UN SYSTEM, 2024



In 2023, UN DESA reported a higher rate of indicators "missing" requirements compared to the UN Secretariat and the overall UN System. Nevertheless, it is worth noting that UN DESA assessed all indicators as applicable.

COMPARISON OF RATINGS BY YEAR, ENTITY SPECIFIC, 2018-2024



From 2018 to 2024, UN DESA maintained a consistent share of indicators rated as "meeting" or "exceeding" requirements.

In 2024, UN DESA made progress by shifting one indicator from "approaching" to "meeting" requirements.
