

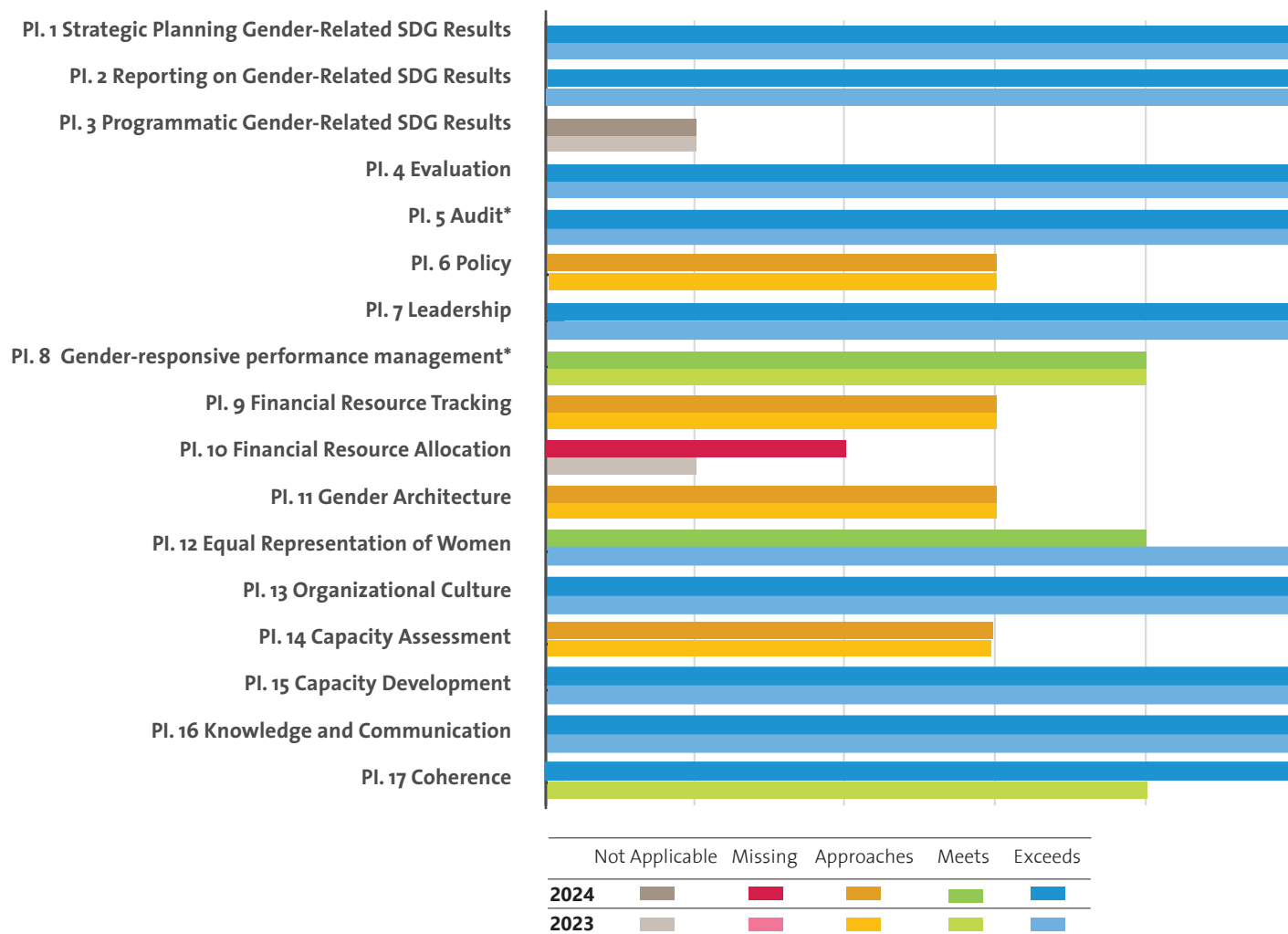

## PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2024

## Most significant gains

- DGC exceeded requirements for nine indicators and met requirements for another two indicators.
- Remarkably, DGC newly exceeded requirements for one indicator: Coherence.

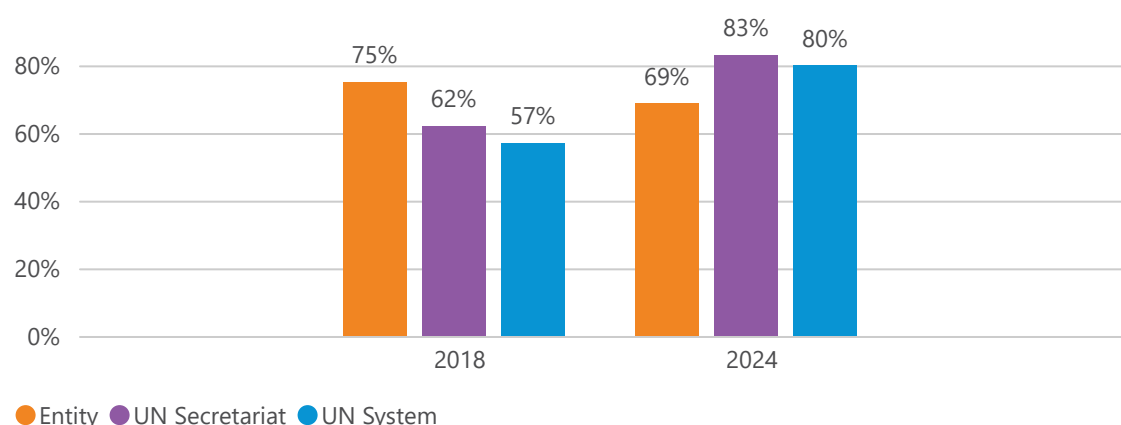
## Areas for improvement

- UN Women encourages DGC to focus efforts on the one indicator missing requirements, financial allocation, and the four indicators approaching requirements: Policy, Financial Resource Tracking, Gender Architecture, and Capacity Assessment.

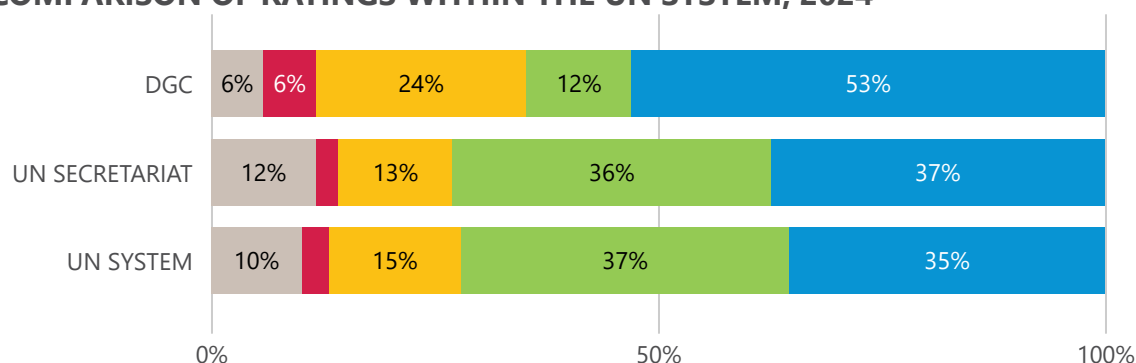
## COMPARISON OF OVERALL PERFORMANCE WITHIN THE UN SYSTEM, 2018-2024

PERCENTAGE OF RATINGS MEETING/EXCEEDING REQUIREMENTS (NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS OMITTED)



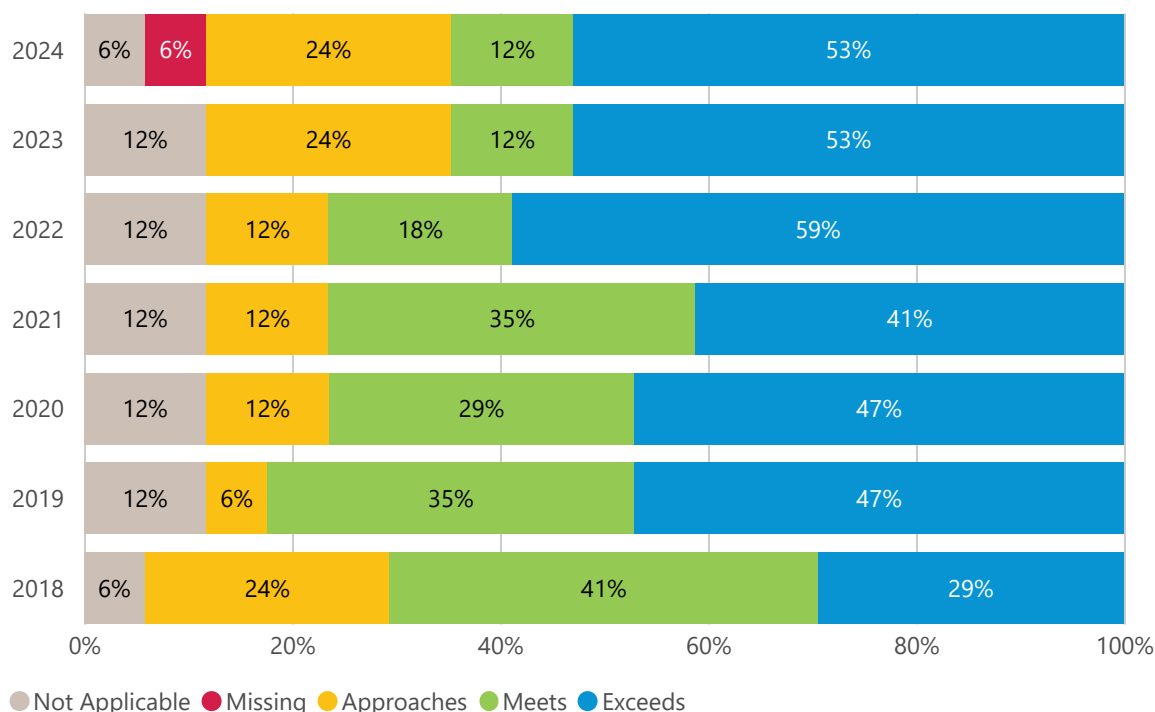
In the performance of DGC was above the average of the UN Secretariat and the overall UN System. In 2023, the entity slightly trailed the average performance of the UN Secretariat and the overall UN System.

## COMPARISON OF RATINGS WITHIN THE UN SYSTEM, 2024



In 2024, DGC exceeded requirements for significantly more indicators than the average of both the UN Secretariat and the UN system.

## COMPARISON OF RATINGS BY YEAR, ENTITY SPECIFIC, 2018-2024



From 2018 to 2024, DGC demonstrated notable progress, "exceeding" nearly twice as many indicators as in earlier years.

In 2024, DGC also identified one indicator as newly "missing" requirements and reported one fewer indicator as "not applicable."
