

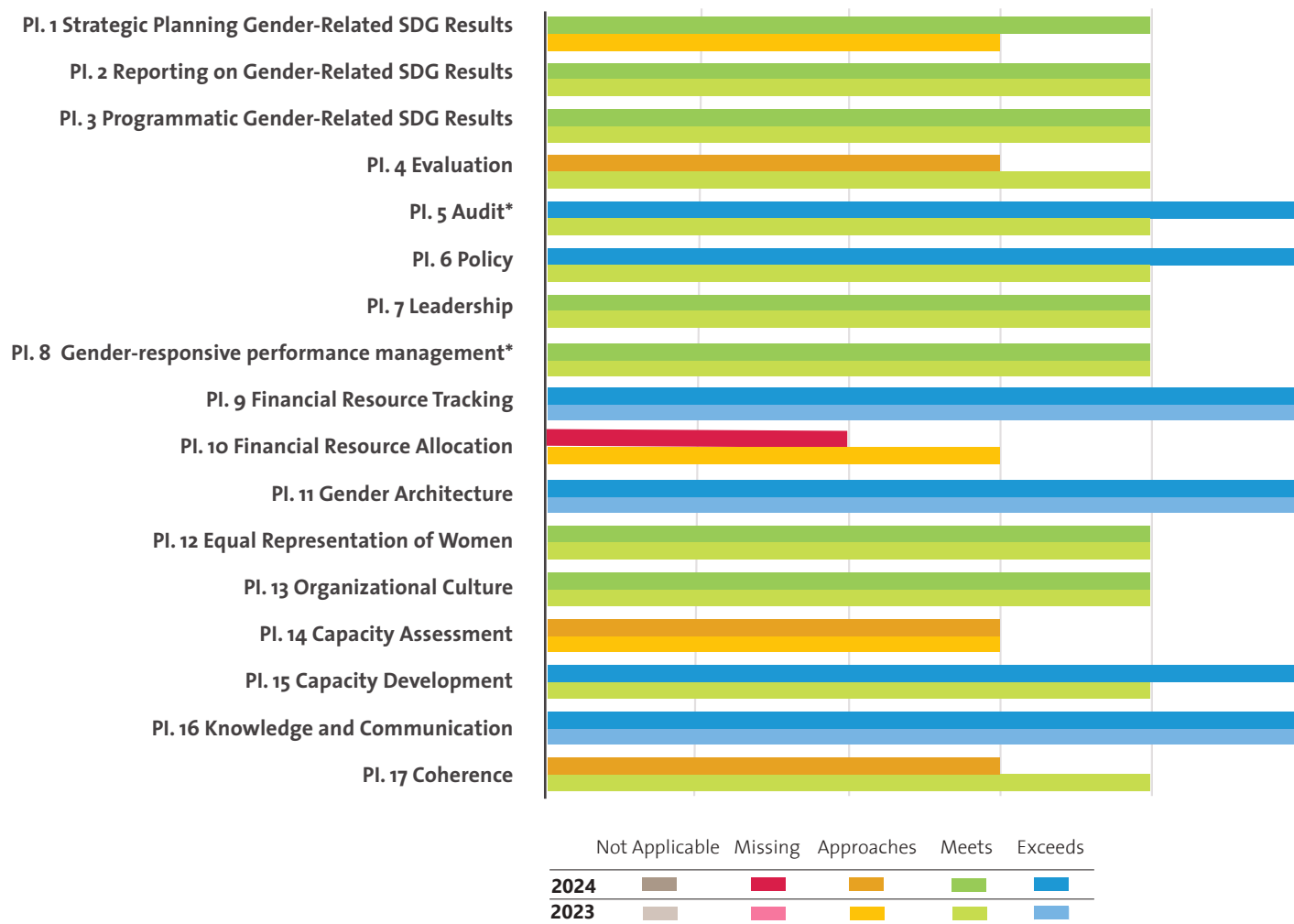

## PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2024

## Most significant gains

- OCHA exceeded six indicators and met requirements for another seven.
- Commendably, in 2024, OCHA newly exceeded requirements for three indicators: Audit, Policy, and Capacity Development.

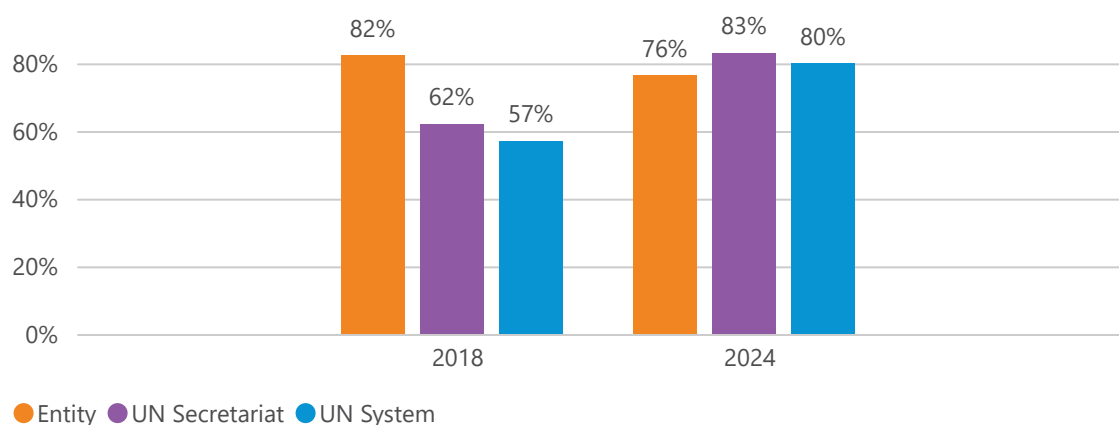
## Areas for improvement

- UN Women encourages OCHA to focus on the three indicators approaching requirements: Evaluation, Capacity Assessment and Coherence.
- Increased focus is also needed to regain the previous achievement on the Finance Resource Allocation indicator, which regressed to missing requirements in 2024.

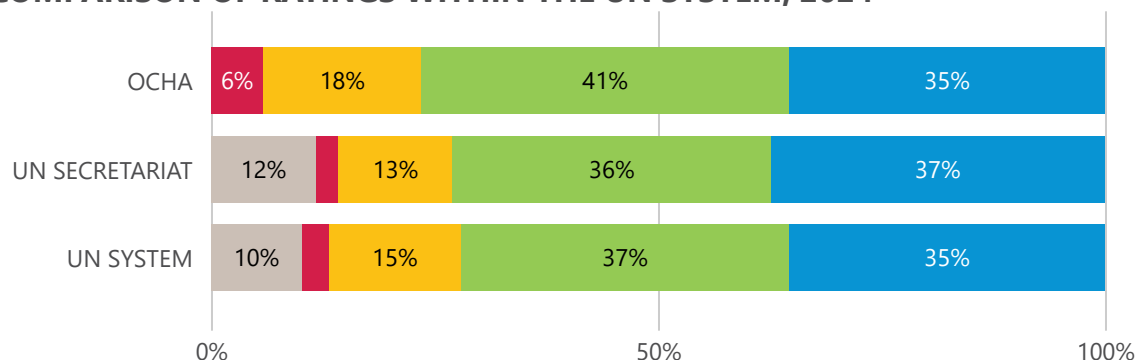
### COMPARISON OF OVERALL PERFORMANCE WITHIN THE UN SYSTEM, 2018-2024

PERCENTAGE OF RATINGS MEETING/EXCEEDING REQUIREMENTS (NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS OMITTED)



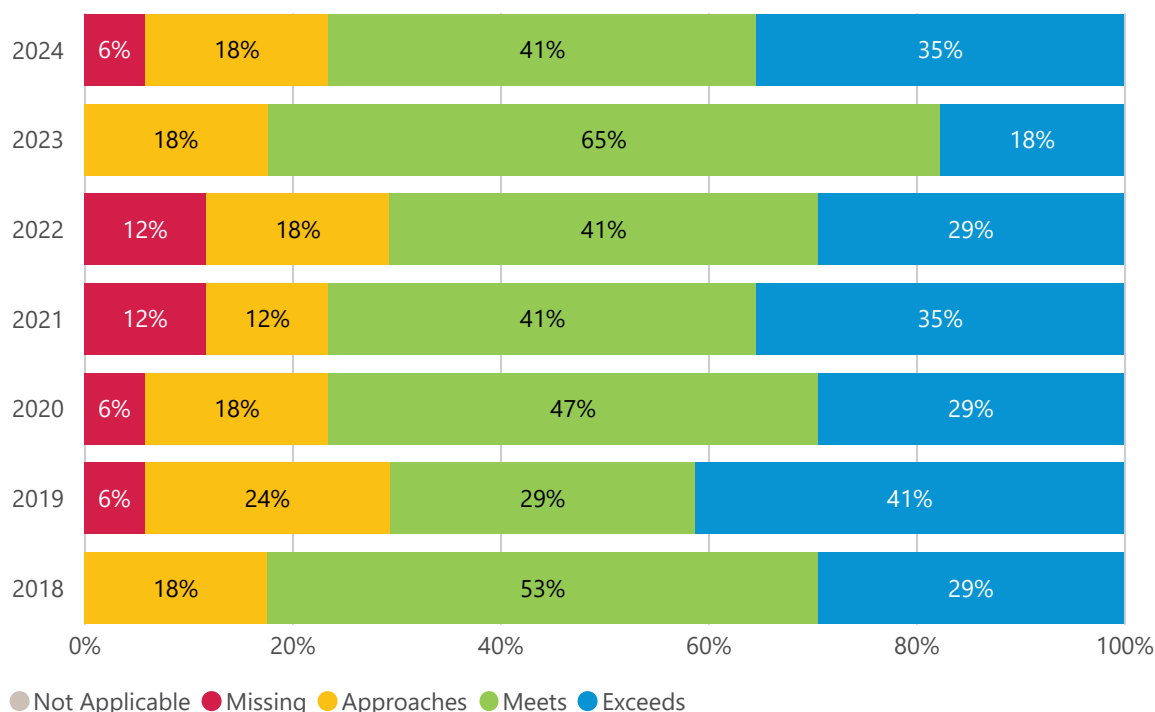
In 2018, OCHA outperformed the average of both UN Secretariat entities and the overall UN System. In 2024, its performance was comparatively lower in the comparison.

### COMPARISON OF RATINGS WITHIN THE UN SYSTEM, 2024



In 2024, OCHA met the requirements for slightly more indicators than the averages for the UN Secretariat and the UN System. The entity rated more indicators as "approaching" or "missing" in comparison.

### COMPARISON OF RATINGS BY YEAR, ENTITY SPECIFIC, 2018-2024



From 2018 to 2024, OCHA maintained consistent performance with meeting and exceeding the requirements for a similar share of indicators.

In 2024, OCHA rated more indicators as "exceeding" compared to its 2023 performance. However, one indicator shifted from "approaching" to "missing".
