

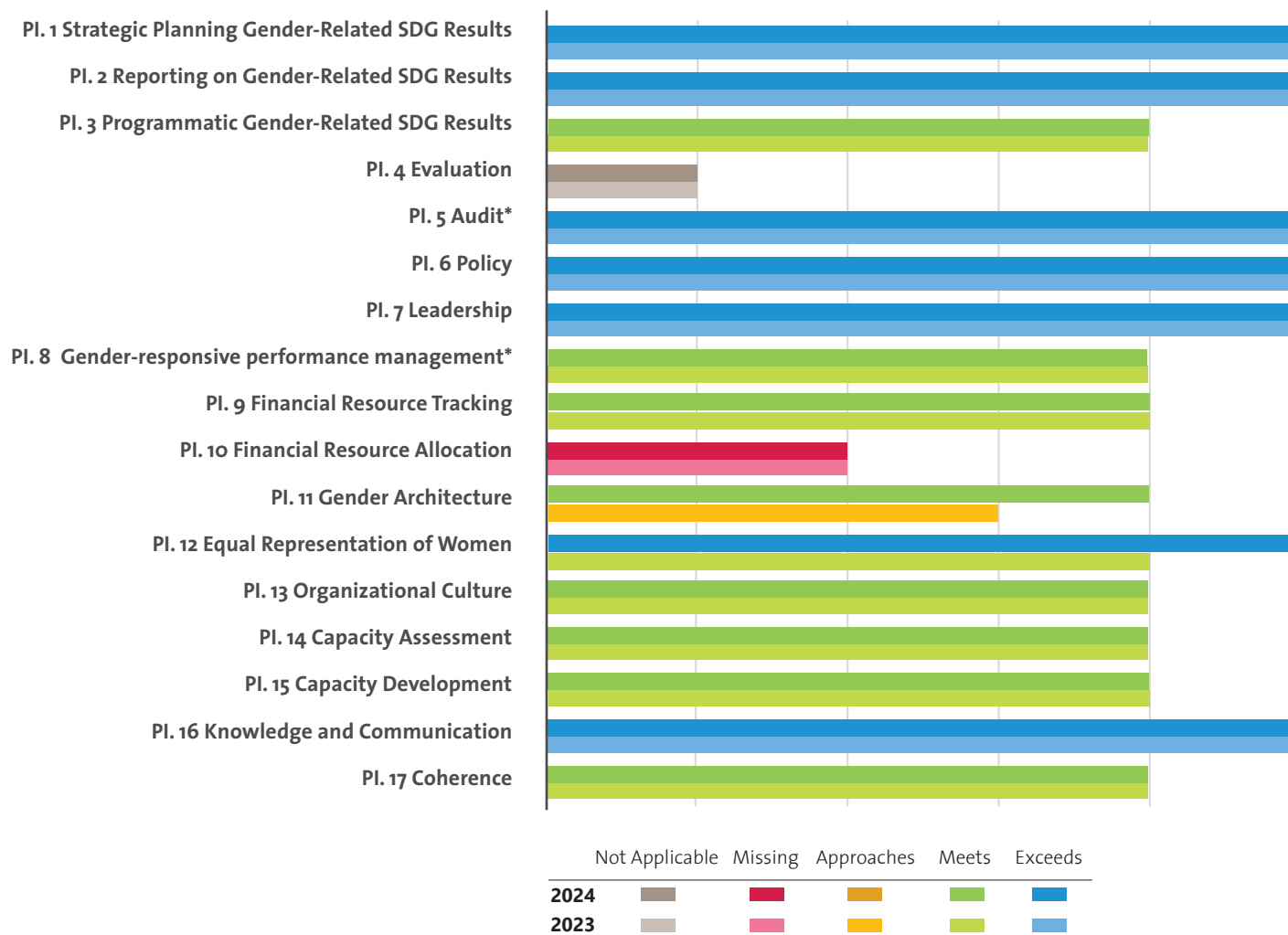

The following three pages capture ODA's performance on UN-SWAP 2.0 indicators for 2024.

In 2024, ODA met or exceeded the requirements for 15 out of 16 applicable performance indicators.

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2024

Most significant gains

- ODA exceeded the requirements for seven indicators and met them for another eight indicators.
- Notably, in 2024, ODA newly exceeded the requirements for the Equal Representation of Women indicator and met them for the Gender Architecture indicator.

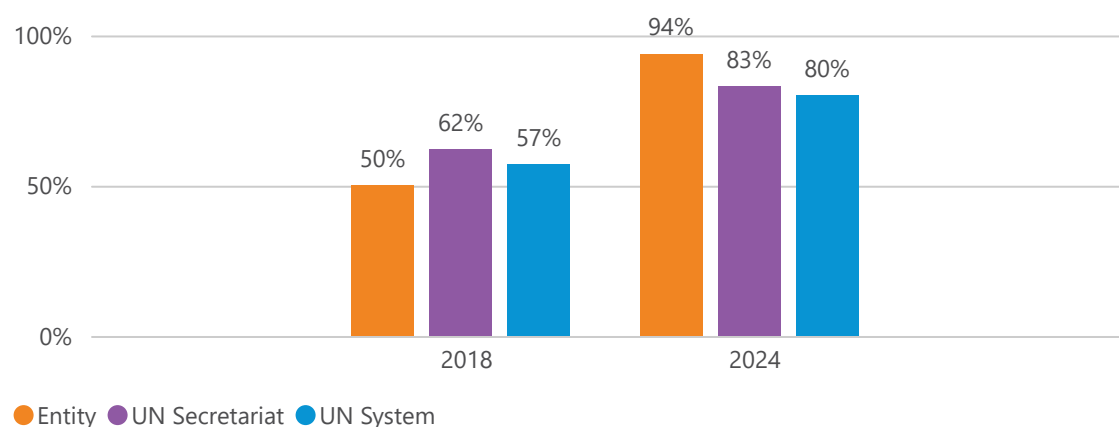
Areas for improvement

- UN Women encourages ODA to focus efforts on the only indicator not yet meeting requirements: Financial Resource Allocation.

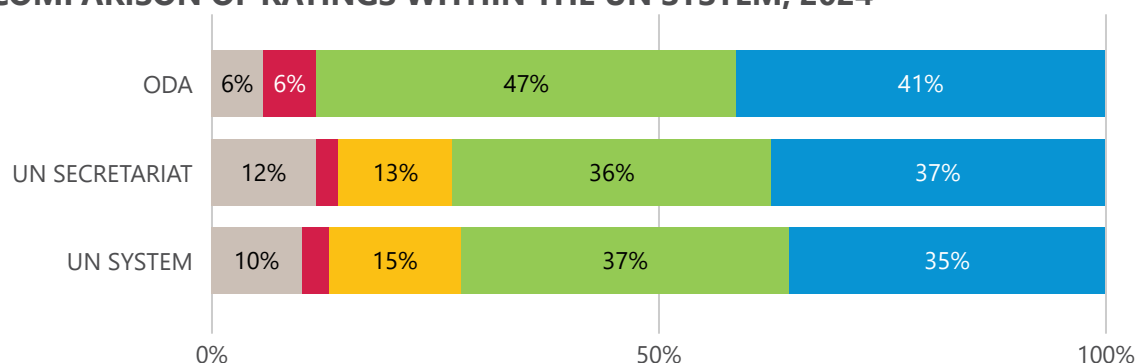

COMPARISON OF OVERALL PERFORMANCE WITHIN THE UN SYSTEM, 2018-2024

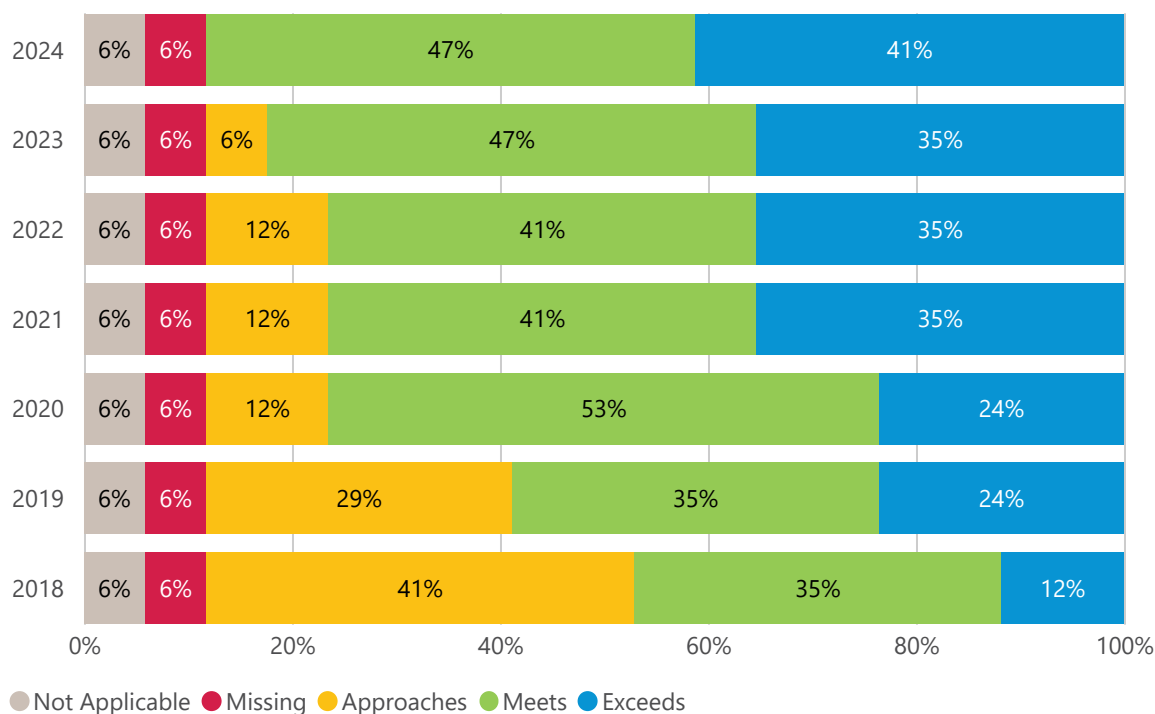
PERCENTAGE OF RATINGS MEETING/EXCEEDING REQUIREMENTS (NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS OMITTED)



In 2018, ODA's share of meeting and exceeding ratings was below the averages of the UN Secretariat and the overall UN System. In 2024, ODA achieved the highest performance in the comparison.

COMPARISON OF RATINGS WITHIN THE UN SYSTEM, 2024

In 2024, ODA "met" and "exceeded" more indicators than the average of both the UN Secretariat and the UN System, and assessed more indicators applicable.

COMPARISON OF RATINGS BY YEAR, ENTITY SPECIFIC, 2018-2024

From 2018 to 2024, ODA achieved solid progress by "exceeding" and "meeting" a significantly greater proportion of indicators.

In 2024, the entity improved upon its 2023 performance by "meeting" one additional indicator and "exceeding" another, marking its strongest UN-SWAP 2.0 performance to date.
