

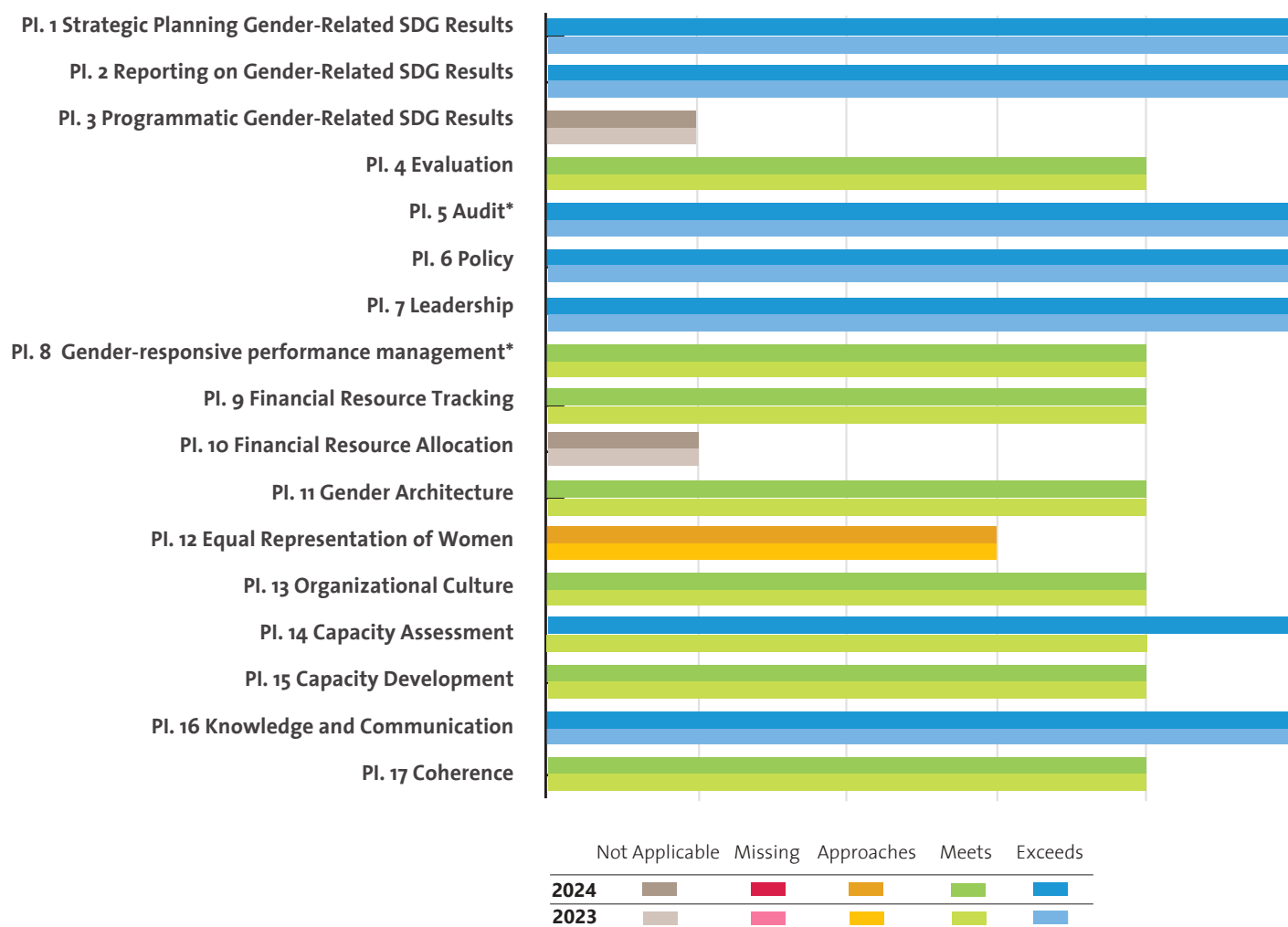

In 2024, UNCTAD met or exceeded the requirements for 14 out of 15 applicable performance indicators.

### PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2024

#### Most significant gains

- UNCTAD exceeded requirements for eight performance indicators and met them for another seven indicators.
- Commendably, in 2024 UNCTAD newly exceeded requirements for the Capacity Assessment indicator.

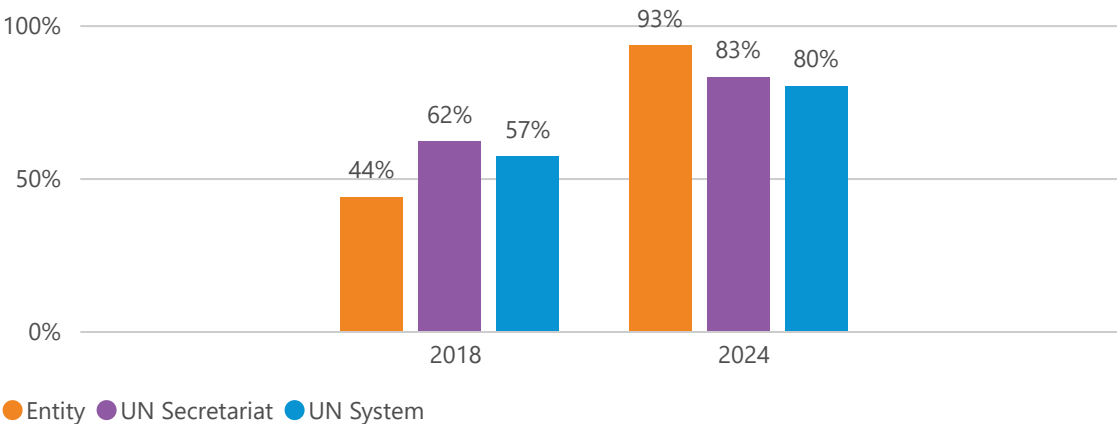
#### Areas for improvement

- UN Women encourages UNCTAD to focus on the only performance indicator that is approaching requirements: Equal representation of women.
- Additionally, UN Women encourages UNCTAD to further reflect on the applicability of the Financial Resource Allocation performance indicator and explore the possibility of establishing a financial benchmark for gender equality and the empowerment of women, drawing on the practices of relevant UN Secretariat entities.

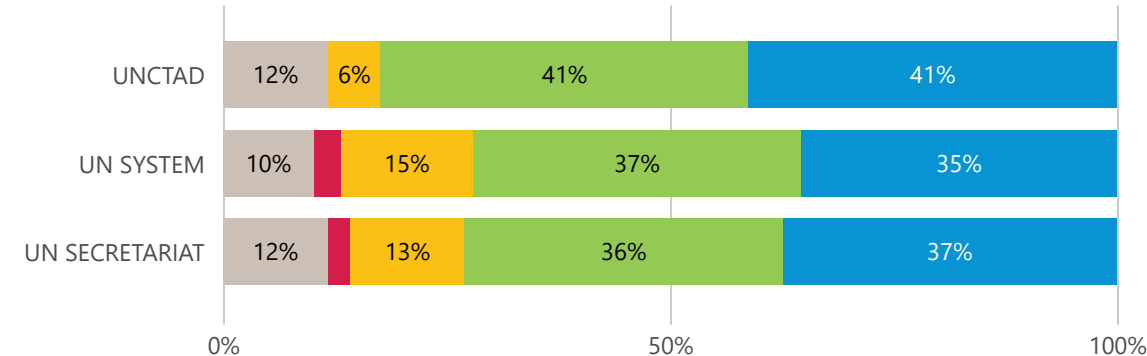
COMPARISON OF OVERALL PERFORMANCE WITHIN THE UN SYSTEM, 2018-2024

PERCENTAGE OF RATINGS MEETING/EXCEEDING REQUIREMENTS (NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS OMITTED)



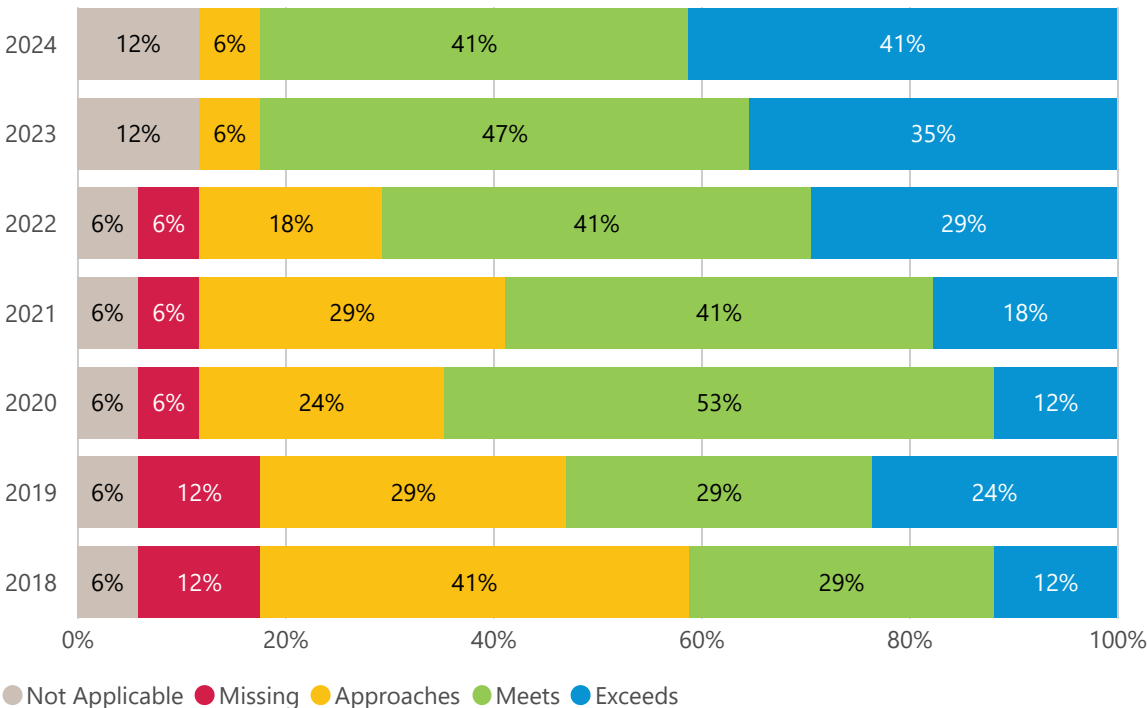
In 2018, UNCTAD trailed behind the average performance of the UN Secretariat and the overall UN System. In 2024, UNCTAD outperformed all, demonstrating significant improvement.

COMPARISON OF RATINGS WITHIN THE UN SYSTEM, 2024



In 2024, UNCTAD met or exceeded the requirements for more indicators than the averages of the UN Secretariat and the UN System. The entity did not miss the requirements for any indicators.

COMPARISON OF RATINGS BY YEAR, ENTITY SPECIFIC, 2018-2024



From 2018 to 2024, UNCTAD demonstrated significant progress by increasingly "meeting" and "exceeding" a greater proportion of performance indicators.

In 2024, UNCTAD further improved upon its 2023 performance by "exceeding" on additional indicator, marking its strongest UN-SWAP 2.0 performance to date.
