

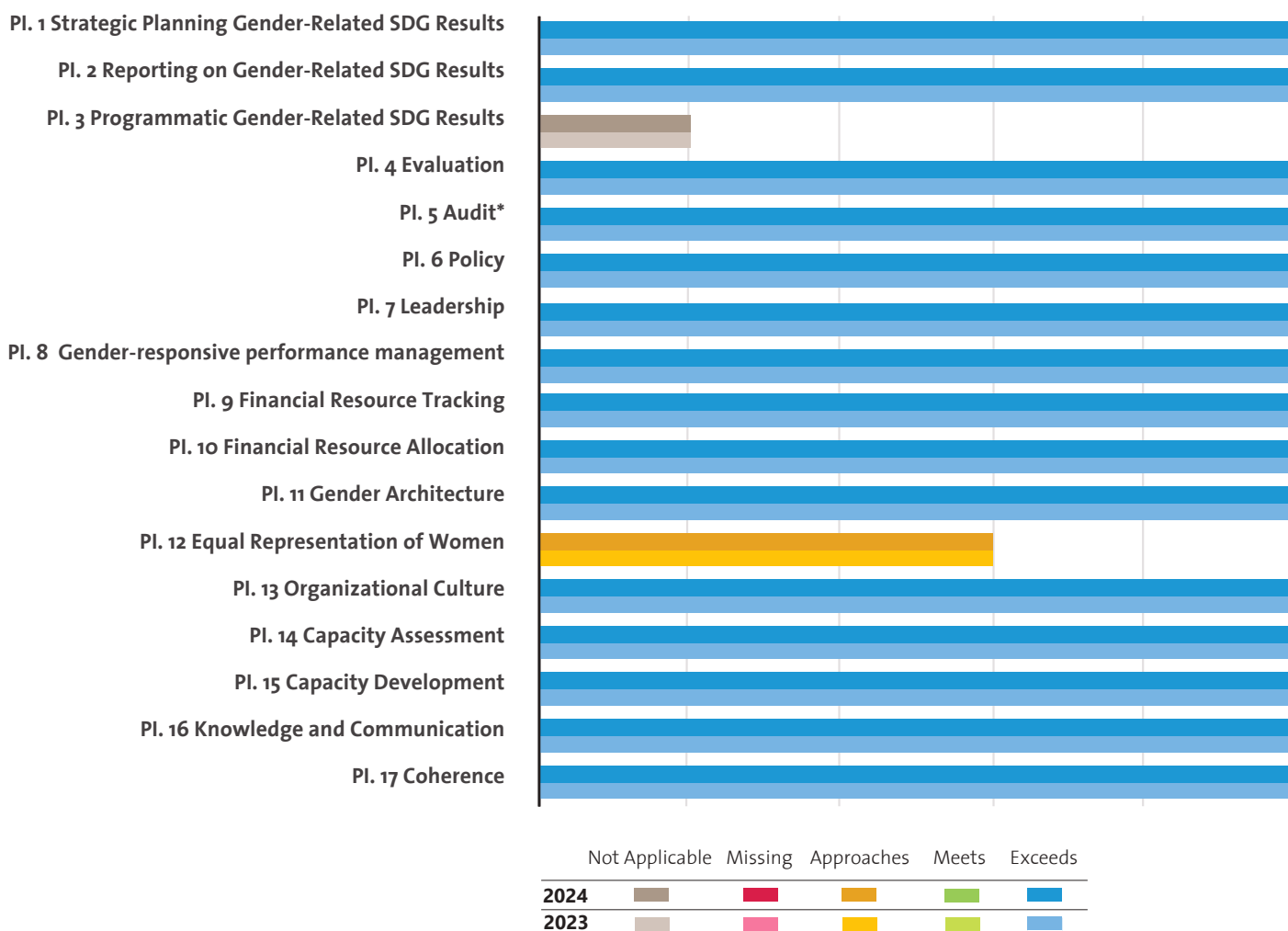

- ESCWA consistently exceeded requirements for 15 out of 16 applicable indicators, a remarkable achievement.

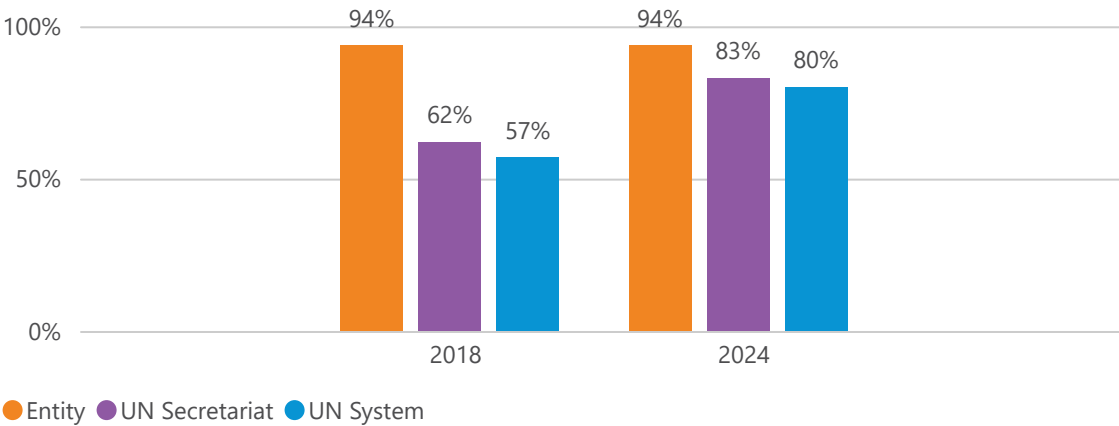
Areas for improvement

* Performance Indicator 5 on Audit is jointly reported for all UN Secretariat entities by OIOS.

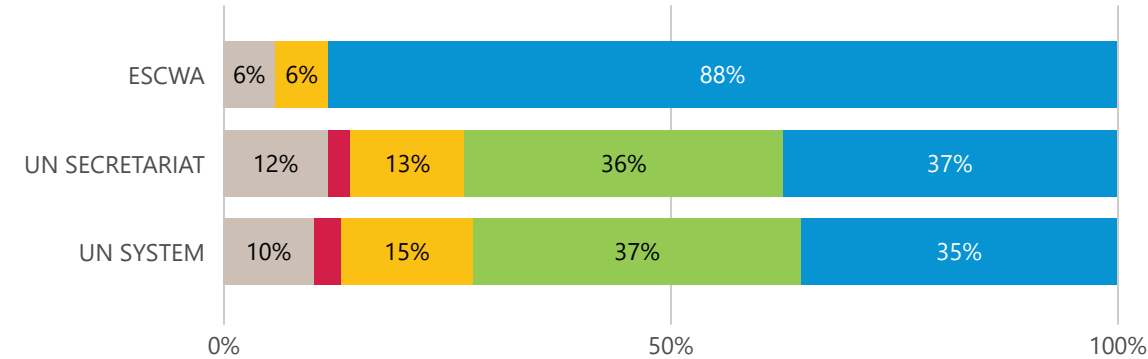
COMPARISON OF OVERALL PERFORMANCE WITHIN THE UN SYSTEM, 2018-2024

PERCENTAGE OF RATINGS MEETING/EXCEEDING REQUIREMENTS (NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS OMITTED)



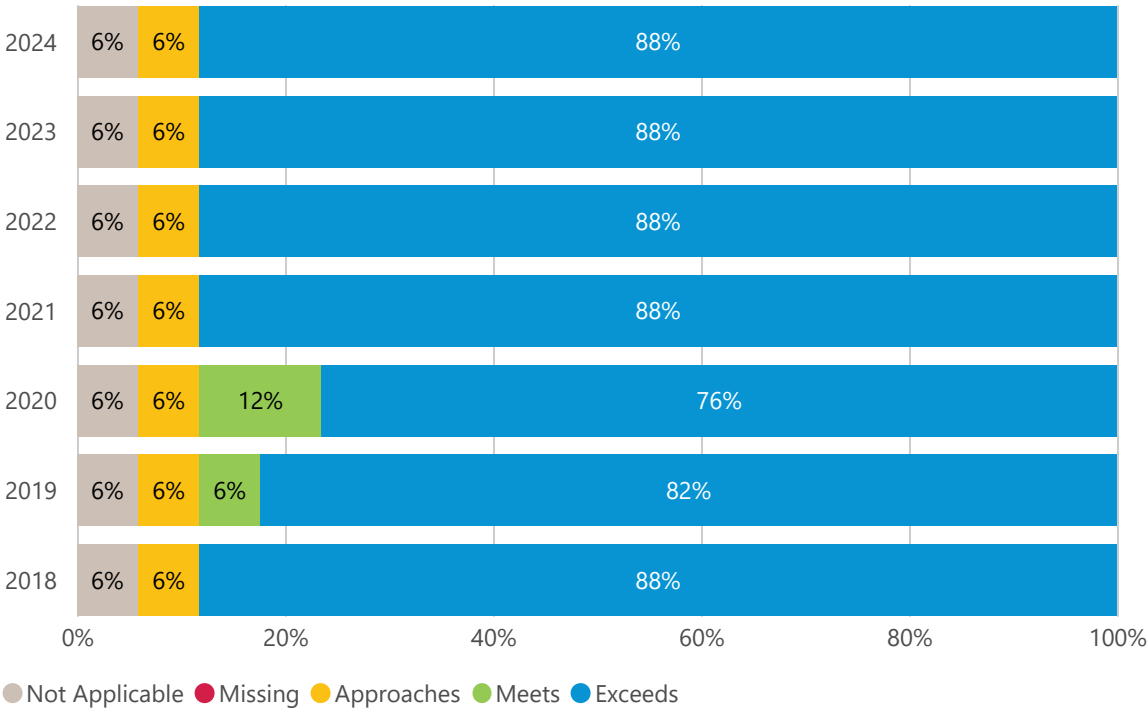
In both 2018 and 2024, ESCWA outperformed the averages of the UN Secretariat and the overall UN System, maintaining strong performance levels consistently.

COMPARISON OF RATINGS WITHIN THE UN SYSTEM, 2024



In 2024, ESCWA met or exceeded the requirements for significantly more indicators than the averages of the UN Secretariat and the UN system as a whole.

From 2018 to 2024, ESCWA sustained its outstanding performance by "exceeding" requirements for a significant proportion of indicators, matching its highest performance levels achieved since 2018.
