

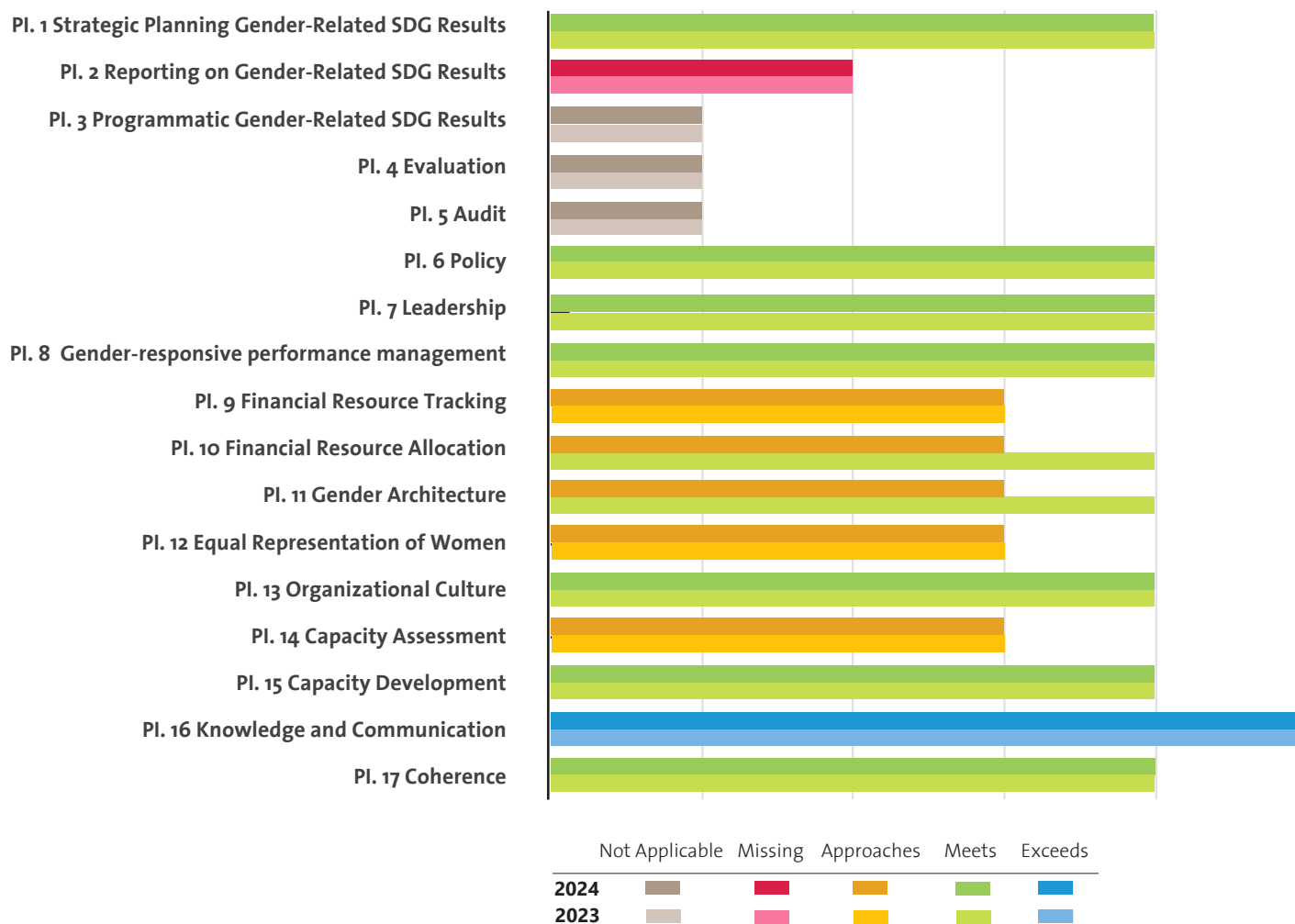

In 2024, UNICRI met or exceeded the requirements for 8 out of 14 applicable performance indicators.

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2024

Most significant gains

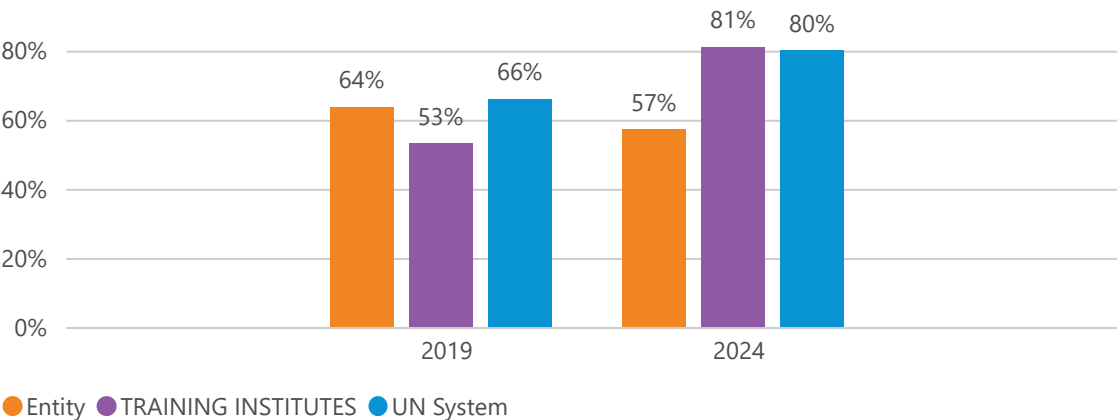
- UNICRI exceeded the requirements for one indicator and met the requirements for another seven indicators.

Areas for improvement

- UN Women encourages UNICRI to focus on the only indicator rated as missing requirements: *Reporting on Gender related SDG results* and the three indicators currently approaching requirements.
- UN Women also encourages UNICRI to recapture the lost progress on the *Financial Resource Allocation* and *Gender Architecture* indicators.

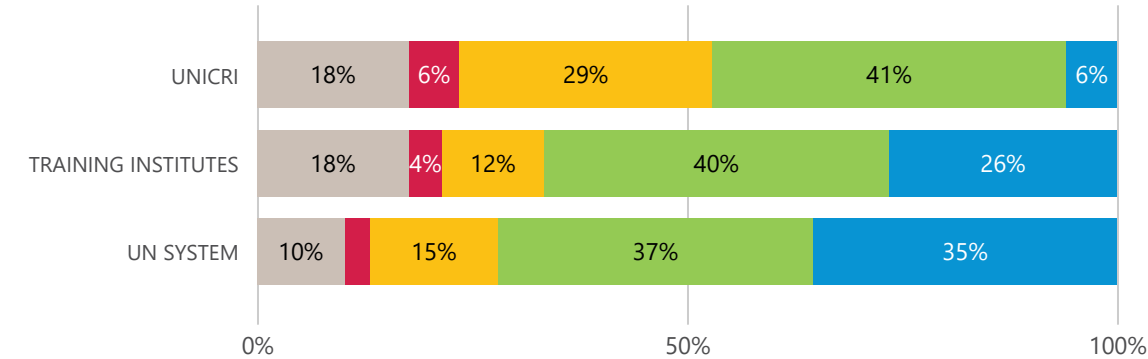
COMPARISON OF OVERALL PERFORMANCE WITHIN THE UN SYSTEM, 2019-2024

PERCENTAGE OF RATINGS MEETING/EXCEEDING REQUIREMENTS (NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS OMITTED)



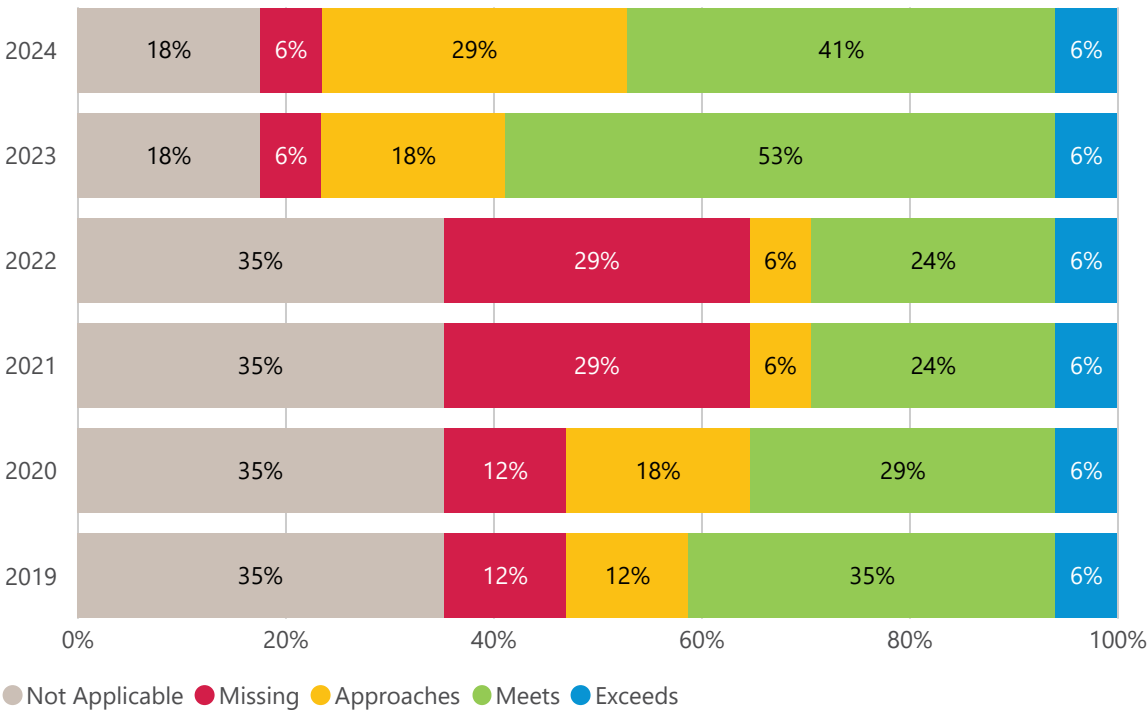
In 2019, UNICRI outperformed the average performance of Training institutes on average. In 2024, both the Training institutes and the UN System as a whole outperformed UNICRI on average.

COMPARISON OF RATINGS WITHIN THE UN SYSTEM, 2024



In 2024, UNICRI met and exceeded the requirements for less indicators than the averages of Training institutes entities and the overall UN System.

COMPARISON OF RATINGS BY YEAR, ENTITY SPECIFIC, 2019-2024



From 2019 to 2024, UNICRI sustained solid progress by meeting the requirements for a growing proportion of UN-SWAP indicators.

In 2024, UNICRI slightly trailed its 2023 performance, with two additional indicators shifting from "meets" to "approaches requirements."
